Also present: Planning 7 Secretary Anna Clune. 8 9 10 **Roll** was called at 7:13. 11 12 **Minutes** Motion was made by Carol Gribble at 7:15 to approve the January 11, 2023, minutes without 13 change, seconded by Andrew Rebillard, approved by all board members present, and passed. 14 15 Motion was made by Andrew Rebillard at 7:18 to approve the February 8, 2023, minutes with 16 one change (line 40: change "voiced an objection" to "expressed a concern"), seconded by Carol 17 18 Gribble, approved by all board members present, and passed. 19 20 5902 South Elm Avenue It was decided that the cancelled public hearing on the special permit application of 5902 South 21 Elm Avenue would not be rescheduled until the Zoning Board completed their public hearing 22 23 and made a decision on the requested variances. Pending the ZBA's actions, the PB would 24 decide how to proceed at their next regularly scheduled meeting on April 12, 2023. 25 Looking at the site plans, Middlebrook pointed out that the proposed parking lot—which would 26 27 sit on top of a steep embankment—was not protected with a rail. This feature would need to be 28 added before the next PB review. Another request was made for an indication of where the pool 29 gates and locks would be located. Adding a landscaping plan was also suggested. 30 31 Some of the details and expense of refurbishing the existing swimming pool were discussed. 32 Middlebrook said that a Certificate of Occupancy would not be forthcoming until the pool was completed and fully compliant with Village code. 33 34 35 **Adjourn:** *Motion* was made at 7:45 pm by Andrew Rebillard to adjourn the meeting and seconded by Carol Gribble.
