Board of Trustees VILLAGE OF MILLERTON Special Workshop Meeting May 10, 2022

The resolution passed unanimously in a roll call vote.

The Clerk reminded Board members that the Pace University sponsored land use training for all three boards would be held Thursday, May 12^{th} and that the next meeting of the Board would be held Monday, May 16^{th} – both scheduled to begin at 6:00 PM.
