# **Special Meeting**

## **Resolution 2023-14 Approval of Election Inspectors**

The resolution was read into the record by the Clerk. A *Motion* was made to approve the election inspectors for the upcoming election on June 20, 2023, by Trustee Sherman and seconded by Trustee Hartzog All (4) present members agreed.

#### **Executive Session**

A *Motion* was made to enter executive session to discuss personnel salaries and matters leading to the appointment, employment, promotion, demotion, discipline, suspension, dismissal, or removal of a particular person at 9:03AM by Trustee Hartzog and seconded by Deputy Mayor Satori. ### Approve the hiring of a part-time seasonal employee.

A *Motion* was made to hire Jose Agustin-Perez as a part time seasonal laborer to maintain the Eddie Collins Memorial Park.at a rate of \$23 per hour by Trustee Hartzog and seconded by Deputy Mayor Satori. All (4) present members agreed.

A *Motion* was made to encumber the remaining funds from g/l line 7130.01 from the 2022-2023 budget to line 7130.01 of the 2023-2024 budget by Deputy Mayor Satori, seconded by Trustee Hartzog. All (4) present members agreed.

#### Approve salary increase for two employees of the police department.

Discussion took place on the salary increases of two of the police officers in the department. The new police chief is recommending that their current salary is too low and to be able to maintain staff they should be given a pay increase. A *Motion* was made to increase the salaries of two police officers by Trustee Sherman and seconded by Deputy Mayor Satori. All (4) present members agreed.
