Lance thanked Linda for the presentation and stated there is no change of use for the building but recommended that she discuss the 17 project with the Department of Health. John & Linda's goal is to launch the business around Memorial 18 Day in 2025. They also intend to collaborate with the NECC by donating any unsold food and providing 19 meals for seniors.
